- Durable, and plastic
- Non-denominational
- Non-toxic
- Non-edible (No food please)
- No gift wrapping as we need to see all items before they are distributed.

Due to safety and infection control guidelines, we are UNABLE to accept:

- Fabric or handmade items
- Items with sand and/or glitter (glitter glue is approved)
- Anything with Latex
- Small rubber balls
- Magnetic toys
- Foam toys/puzzles
- Anything breakable (i.e. ceramic, glass)
- Candles
