The University of Chicago "Giving to Help" Campaign giving guide lists many charities along with code numbers that enable efficient processing. (Inclusion in this guide does not reflect endorsement by the University of Chicago.) However, you are not limited to the charities printed in this guide. You may choose any non-profit organization in which you are interested.

Payment Method

Donations can be made in 2 ways – through payroll deduction or direct gift. Please check one of the boxes.

Payroll Deduction

Check the first box; then decide the amount you wish to pledge each month. Enter this pledge amount per month and multiply by the number of months left in the year, which is determined by when you submit your pledge. For example, if you turn in your pledge form before January 1, then you would multiply by 12, or fewer if you wish. Enter total pledge on the line indicated. (If you select this option, your pledge will be paid to the charities of your choice in two installments – the first in mid-summer, and the second at the conclusion of the year.)

Direct Gift by Check

Check the second box and enter the amount you wish to give. Important – make checks payable to individual charities, not to the University of Chicago. This enables us to send your check directly to the charity and include it in the University's campaign. Be sure to include a mailing address.

Anonymous

If you wish to remain anonymous, please check the box in this section. Your name will not be reported to the charities you support.

Designations

This section allows you to list the charities that you wish to support and the amount that you wish to donate to each. Please enter the charity name, full address, code number which is found in the index and in the body of this guide (if the charity is listed in this guide), and the amount of your gift in the spaces provided. Pledge forms have space for five charities. If you wish to donate to more than five, please use another pledge form. To give to a University of Chicago department not listed on page 6, use code #996 or to other agencies not listed, use code #999 and provide name, address, city, state, and zip code.

In October 20, 2013, Shedd Aquarium announced the launch of the most ambitious solar panel installation of any cultural institution in Illinois. Shedd is currently in the first phase of installing 913 photovoltaic solar panels on the roof of its Abbott Oceanarium. The 265-kilowatt solar electrical system is part of the aquarium's

Master Energy Roadmap, an energy initiative aimed at cutting energy consumption by 50% by 2020, which would make Shedd the nation's first clean energy-powered aquarium.
