Dr. Kan is a Consultant at the Department of Radiology at the Hong Kong Children's Hospital. She also serves as an Honorary Clinical Associate Professor in the Faculty of Medicine at The University of Hong Kong.

Dr. Kan graduated from the Faculty of Medical and Health Sciences of the University of Auckland, New Zealand. She is a Fellow of the Royal College of Radiologists and Hong Kong College of Radiologists. She completed a mini fellowship in Pediatric Radiology at the Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center, USA. As a young fellow she was awarded the Hong Kong Hospital Authority Corporate Scholarship, and she received training in Paediatric Neuroradiology at the Great Ormond Street Children's Hospital in London, United Kingdom. She underwent further subspecialty training in Fetal Neuroimaging at Guys and St. Thomas Hospital in London, United Kingdom, when she was awarded the Hong Kong College of Radiologists 15A Traveling Scholarship.

Dr. Kan is a member of the Scientific Subcommittee of the Hong Kong College of Radiologists and an active member of the Asian-Oceanic Society of Paediatric Radiology. As a member of Radiology Workgroup for Hong Kong Children's Hospital and the secretary of Task Force on Development of Hong Kong Children's Hospital (Radiology), Dr Kan is a vital member of the commissioning team of the Department of Radiology.

Dr. Kan has a special interest in neuro-imaging and her recent publications cover topics on paediatric and fetal neuro-radiology. As an invited speaker, she has presented invited lectures on a wide spectrum of topics including paediatric urinary tract and renal diseases, paediatric emergency neuro-imaging, safe use of contrast media, radiation safety and foetal neuro-imaging.
