100YLA Online Series Begins April 30, 8pm HKT

Life expectancy in Asia has increased significantly from 1955 to 2020. In many Asian societies, centenarians are still celebrated, but they are no longer a rarity. Society and government policies have not been designed around the expectation that people will live to 100.

The Yuen Lecture Series is going to present you an online conversation series with Kathleen Cagney, Professor of Sociology and Chair of 100 Year Lives in Asia (100YLA) which will explore the education, career, family, financial security and many other topics to address the changing needs people and their families have as they prepare to live longer lives while facing a COVID-19 future.

Episode 1: Social Relationships and COVID-19

In this episode, Professor Cagney will have a dialogue with her colleague Linda Waite from Urban Sociology and Tian Xiaoli (PhD '11) from the University of Hong Kong to discuss how COVID-19 is affecting the social relationships of the elderly, and how family, community and friendship can play a part in mitigating loneliness. The session will last for an hour.
