### Professor Nicholas Stephanopoulos

Nicholas Stephanopoulos is Professor of Law at Harvard Law School, where his research and teaching interests include election law, constitutional law, administrative law, legislation, and comparative law. He was previously the Professor of Law and Herbert and Marjorie Fried Research Scholar at the University of Chicago Law School. He is a graduate of Yale Law, where he was Editor-in-Chief of the *Yale Journal of International Law*. He received his M.Phil. in European Studies from Cambridge and an A.B. in government from Harvard. He is a co-founder of PlanScore, a website evaluating past, present, and proposed district plans. He is also a member of policy reform initiatives including the Campaign Legal Center's Litigation Strategy Council and the Committee for the Study of Digital Platforms. Professor Staphanopoulos has been named to The Politico 50 list and the National Law Journal's "Chicago 40 Under 40." He has been involved in several litigation efforts, including a pair of partisan gerrymandering lawsuits based in part on his academic work that recently reached the Supreme Court. He is also a frequent television and radio commentator on legal issues, and his writings have appeared both in major popular publications like the *New York Times* and academic journals like the *University of Chicago Law Review*.
