## CAR T Cell Therapy: Supercharging blood cells to defeat cancer

There's a breakthrough in the fight against cancer, and it's making headlines around the world. Called CAR T-cell therapy, the treatment supercharges a patient's white blood cells to seek out and destroy cancer cells. Research at UChicago Medicine played a key role in the development of this exciting new immunotherapy for advanced blood cancers. UChicago Medicine is the first site in the country to be certified for FDA-approved CAR T-cell therapies for specific blood cancers in both adult and pediatric patients.
