Dr. Carina W. Yang is Assistant Professor in the Department of Radiology at the University of Chicago, serving as the Director of Pediatric Neuroradiology. She also directs the neuroradiology fellowship, which serves a complement of three fellows each academic year. She has published over 15 peer-reviewed primary journal articles in the field. As an invited speaker, she has presented on pediatric neuroradiology topics during invited lectures, including completing visiting professorships in Newfoundland, Canada and Gwalior, India.

Dr. Yang completed bachelor of science degrees in Chemical Engineering, Biology, and Literature at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in Cambridge, Massachusetts. A graduate of Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine, Dr. Yang completed a diagnostic radiology residency at McGaw Medical Center of Northwestern University in Chicago, Illinois. She stayed on to complete a diagnostic neuroradiology fellowship at Northwestern, before joining the pediatric neuroradiology faculty at Children's Memorial Hospital in Chicago (now known at Ann & Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago). She then joined the neuroradiology faculty at the University of Chicago in 2013.

Dr. Yang is a member of the Publication Committee of the American Society of Pediatric Neuroradiology. She has additional expertise in and a passion for radiology simulation, which she pioneered at the University of Chicago in 2013. She conducts multiple contrast reaction code simulations each academic year and is pursuing innovative research in the use of task-trainer as well as virtual 3D technique for image-guided spine procedures. She serves as the Co-chair of the Department of Radiology Diversity Committee and organized the first medical student University of Chicago Radiology Expo last year. She is the Faculty Advisor for the University of Chicago Pritzker School of Medicine Medical Chinese Group.
