The University of Chicago's International House is pleased to announce the 2020-2021 Graduate Fellowship program for non-resident graduate students.

Amount: \$1,000 - \$3,000 Fellowships are awarded on a quarterly basis; a full fellowship of \$3000 would be disbursed in three quarterly payments of \$1000.

Eligibility: University of Chicago graduate students who will be registered for the full academic year.

Criteria: Academic merit and the demonstrated interest in the social and intellectual life of International House.

Deadline:
5pm March 27 for April 10 decision;
5pm May 1 for May 15 decision;
5pm June 19 for July 3 decision

Selection Process

Fellows are expected to contribute their unique perspectives and interests to the International House community and become fully engaged in the multi-faceted life of the House through a wide array of activities for UChicago grads offered throughout the year through the Graduate Commons Program. Programming includes internationally-focused public programs through the Global Voices Performing Arts and Lecture Series, weekly language and culture tables and related dining activities, professional development opportunities, health and wellness programs, social activities and much more!

Factors for selection may include, but are not limited to: evidence of leadership abilities, involvement in community and university organizations, extracurricular interests in areas such as performing arts, athletics, and cultural activities, participation in community service, and contributions to increasing diversity. Once selected, Graduate Fellows must remain in good academic standing and abide by all of the rules and policies of International House and the University of Chicago. Graduate Fellows must also demonstrate ongoing participation in the International House community.
