The University of Chicago's International House is pleased to announce the 2022-2023 Graduate Fellowship program for graduate students.

Amount: \$1,000 - \$3,000 Fellowships are awarded on a quarterly basis; a full fellowship of \$3000 would be disbursed in three quarterly payments of \$1000.

Criteria: Academic merit and the demonstrated interest in the social and intellectual life of International House.

Eligibility: University of Chicago graduate students who will be registered for the full academic year. Incoming students must have accepted their University offer and may be required to submit proof.

#### Deadline:

5pm CST March 25 for April 8 decision; 5pm CST April 29 for May 13 decision; 5pm CST June 17 for July 1 decision

### **Selection Process**

Fellows are expected to contribute their unique perspectives and interests to the International House community and become fully engaged in the multi-faceted life of the House through a wide array of activities for UChicago grads offered throughout the year through the Graduate Commons Program. Programming includes internationally-focused public programs through the Global Voices Performing Arts and Lecture Series, weekly language and culture tables, professional development opportunities, health and wellness programs, social activities, the Global Mentorship Network, and much more!

Factors for selection may include, but are not limited to: evidence of leadership abilities, involvement in community and university organizations, extracurricular interests in areas such as performing arts, athletics, and cultural activities, participation in community service, and contributions to increasing diversity. Once selected, Graduate Fellows must remain in good academic standing and abide by all of the rules and policies of International House and the University of Chicago. Graduate Fellows must also demonstrate ongoing participation in the International House community.

The completed application form must be submitted to International House by e-mail at i-house-programs@uchicago.edu. Please use your uchicago.edu email address and include your name and page number on every page of your application materials. If your uchicago.edu email address has not yet been generated, you will also need to submit proof of acceptance of your University offer.
