Monday, May 26

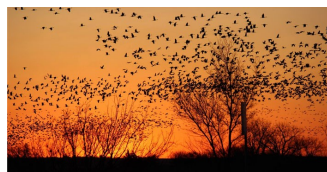
I-House BBQ & Mini-Frolic

5:30 PM in the Courtyard

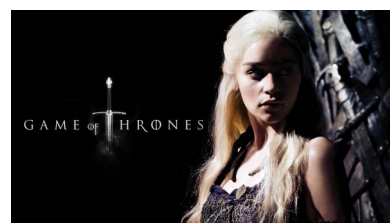
