NAUC also seeks to educate UC students on issues surrounding immigration and naturalization from this immersive experience in immigrant communities.
Phoenix Development Fund	Phoenix Development Fund is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that provides pro-bono business development services to small businesses and non-profits in socioeconomically disadvantaged Chicago neighborhoods. Our members have the opportunity to use and develop their in-classroom learning, professional, and leadership skills to make meaningful impacts through our engagements.
Phoenix Farms	Phoenix Farms is UChicago's urban farming and beekeeping organization. Now in our second year, we provide an opportunity for UChicago students to tend their own garden plots and keep bees during the spring, summer and early fall months of the year, a time traditionally less served by RSOs.
Project Reproductive Freedom	Project Reproductive Freedom works to bring awareness to reproductive justice issues on the UChicago campus and beyond. We advocate for reproductive freedom for all through raising awareness about threats to reproductive freedom and actively supporting local reproductive rights and reproductive justice organizations in Chicago.
Promontory Investment Research	PIR aims to contribute to the existing literature on investment products available to the general public, by publishing research-substantiated ratings. Our ratings will be a culmination of research reports, and covers equity market products (stocks) and macro market products (forex, ETFs). In addition to this core purpose, PIR seeks to train our club members in the procedures of analyzing investment products.
