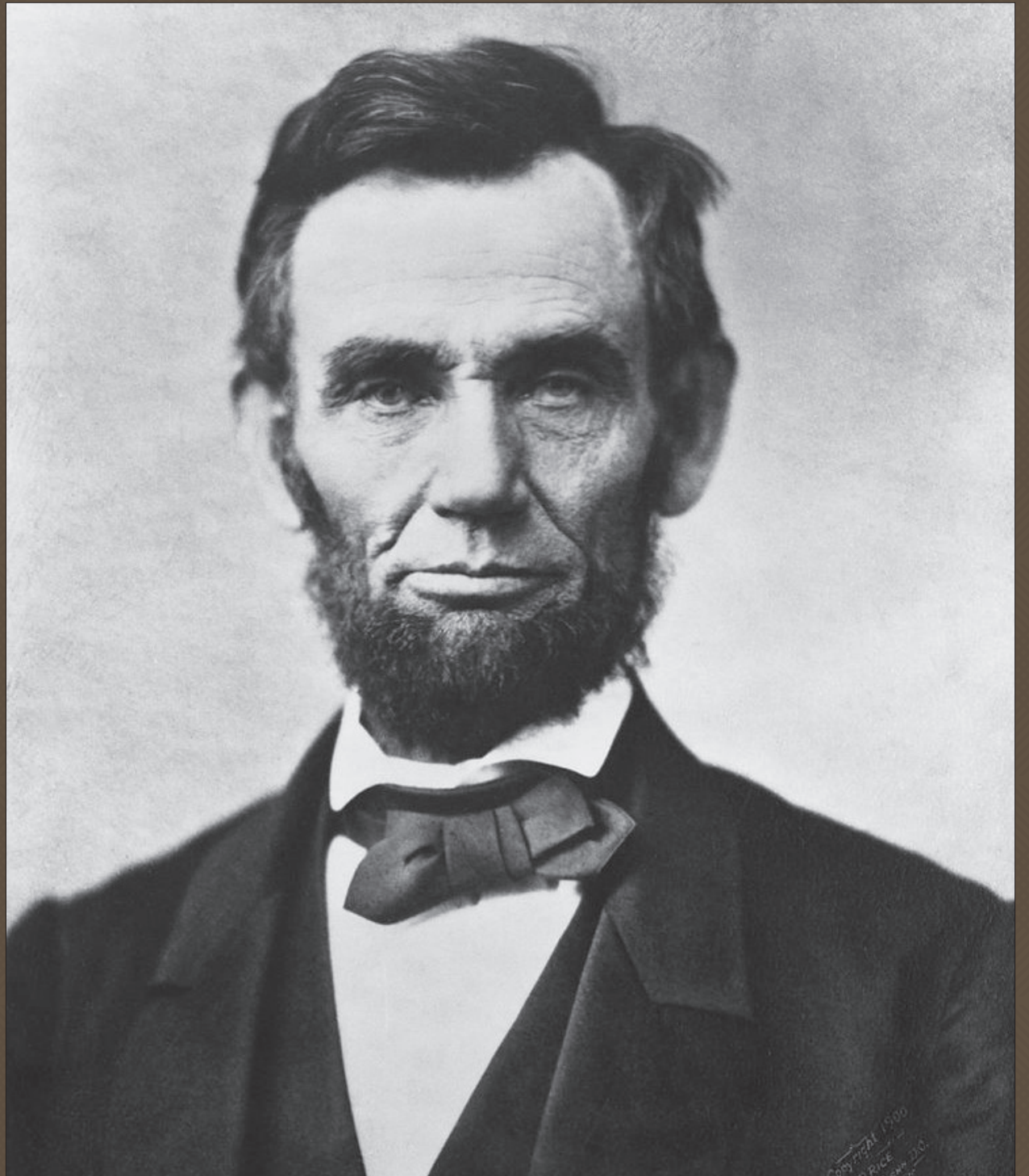

David Bromwich is Sterling Professor of English at Yale. Bromwich is a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. He has published widely on Romantic criticism and poetry, and on eighteenth-century politics and moral philosophy. His book *Politics by Other Means* concerns the role of critical thinking and tradition in higher education, and defends the practice of liberal education against political encroachments from both Left and Right.
