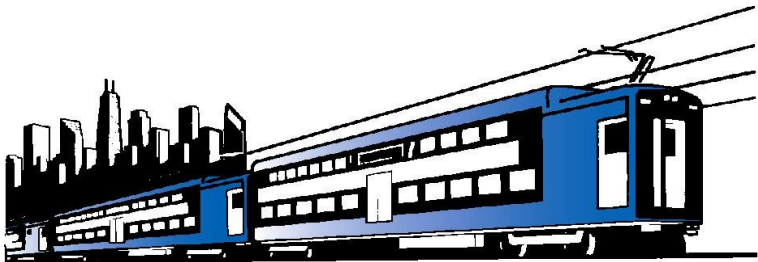

TRAIN SCHEDULE ON REVERSE

Metra—for business or leisure trips into the City to visit museums, attend concerts, shop, dine and more! For connecting CTA bus information, visit rtachicago.com or call 773.836.7000. Buses serving University of Chicago and Metra Electric Stations include #170, 171, and 172.

Station Information:

59th Street: Located along South Lake Park Avenue at 59th St.

Hyde Park 51st/53rd Street: Located along South Lake Park Avenue between 51st and 53rd Streets.

55th/56th/57th Street: Located along South Lake Park Avenue at 55th, 56th and 57th Streets.

Millennium Station: Below ground on Michigan Ave., between South Water and Randolph St. Access is adjacent to the Cultural Center on Randolph. Other downtown stations are also located along Michigan at

VanBuren/Jackson and the Museum Campus at 11th St.

Buying your Ticket:

By internet: Visit www.metrarail.com and follow links to "Tickets" where you can use American Express, Mastercard, Visa or Discover. Allow at least 5 business days to receive ticket.

At the station: Metra Electric stations have automated ticket machines. Van Buren and Millennium stations also have agents on duty most hours, every day of the week. Personal checks are accepted from residents of IL, WI and IN with ID.

Mobile Ticketing: Coming autumn 2015, buy tickets with your Smartphone. Visit metrarail.com for info.

On the train: When there is no automated ticket machine or station agent on duty you may buy a one-way ticket or Weekend Pass from the conductor on the train. However, if a ticket was available at the station, yet you board without one, a \$3.00 surcharge will apply.

Fares—Zone B:

- One-way ticket \$3.50
Ten-ride ticket \$31.50
Monthly Pass \$99.75
