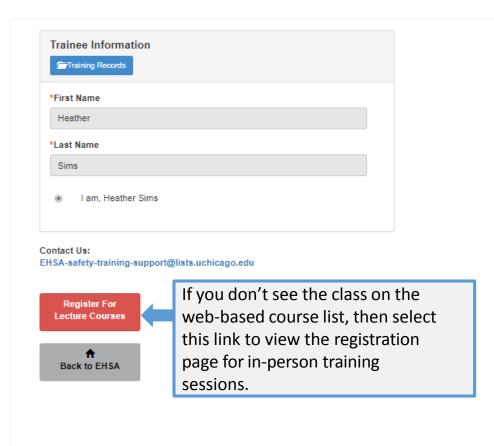


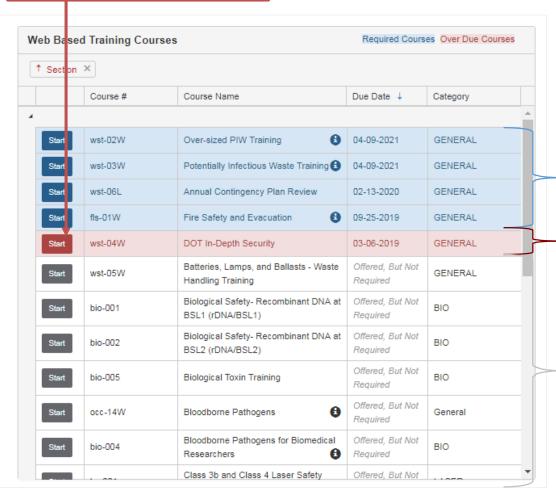

Click "Start" to begin the web-based training class



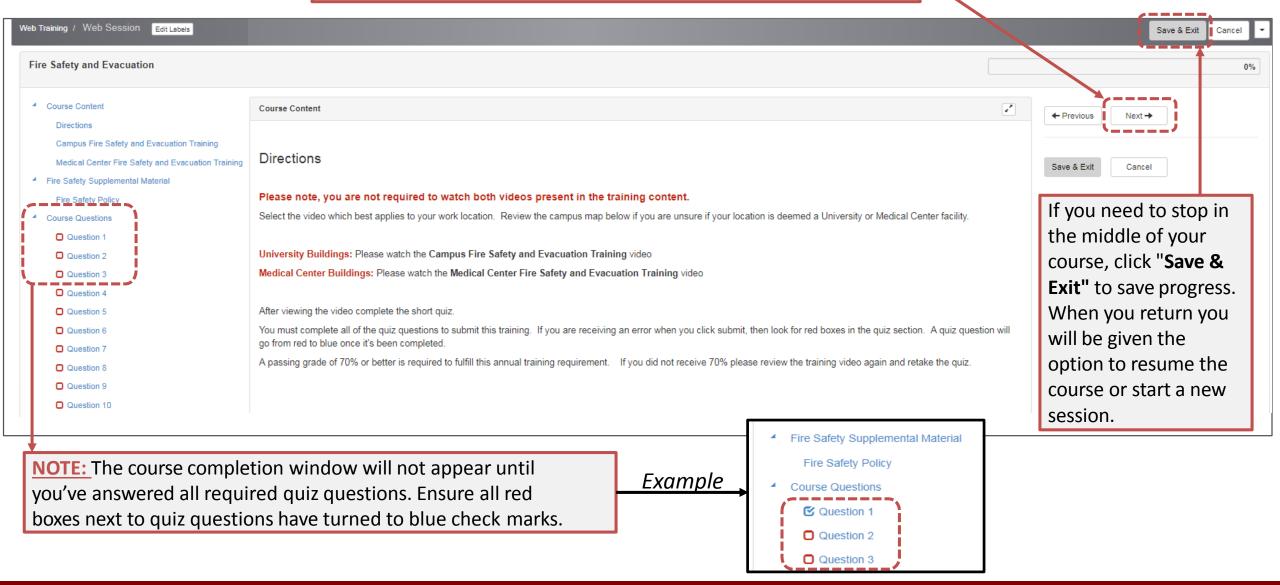


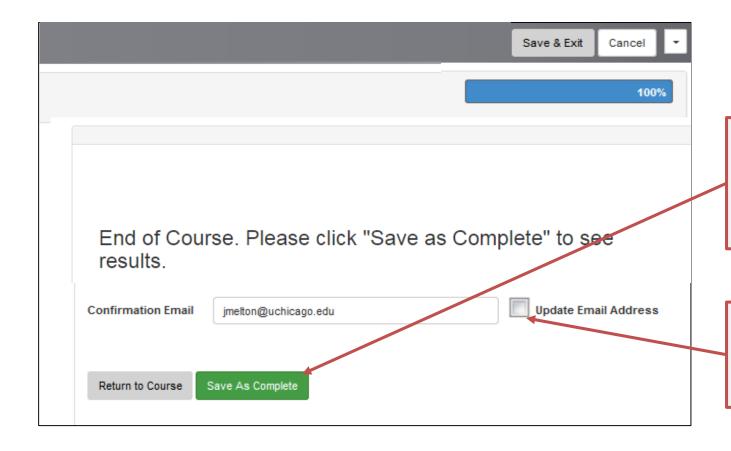

To reserve a seat for a course session, click the **Register** button

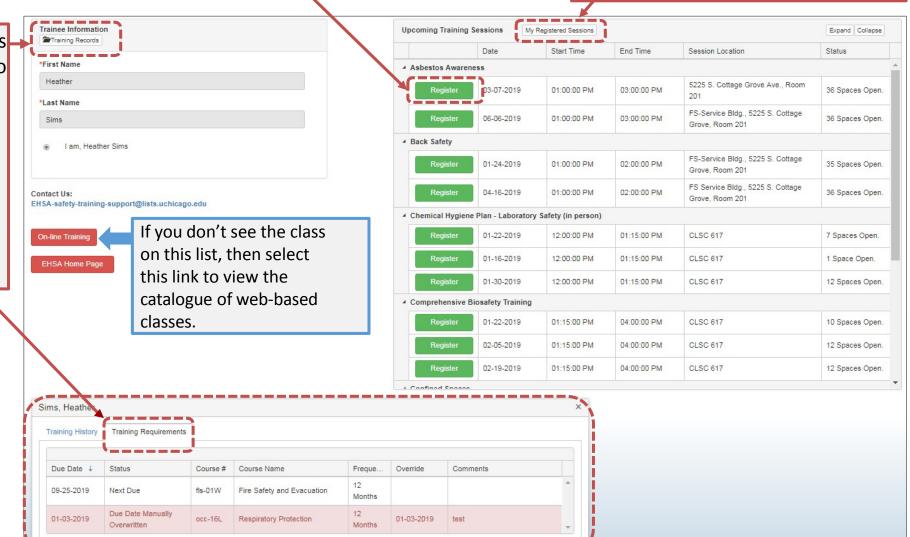

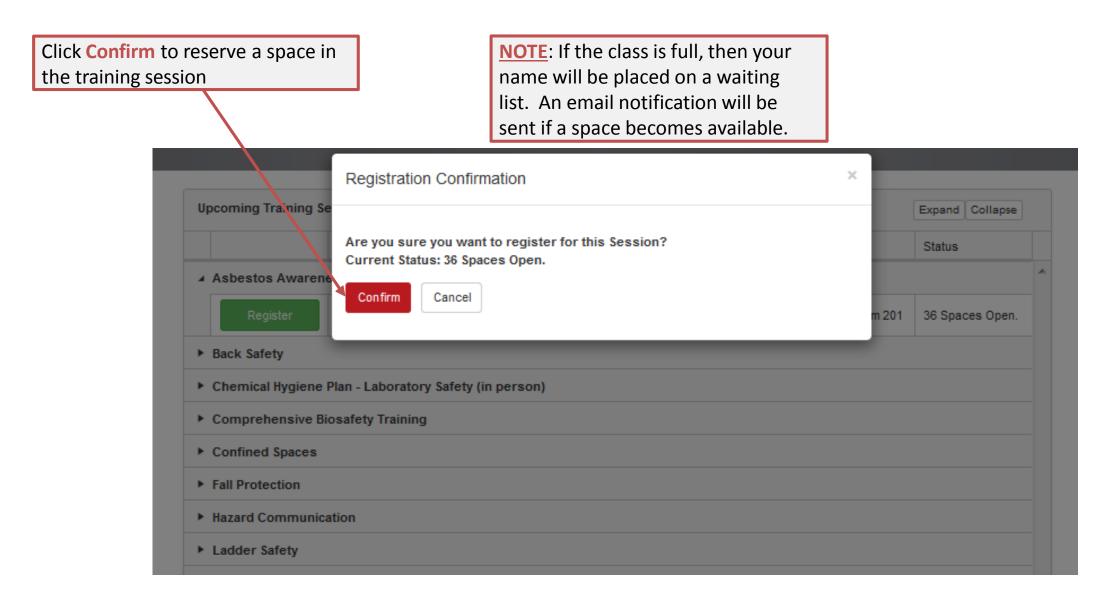
If you would like to view the due dates for the list of safety classes assigned to you, then select "Training Records"

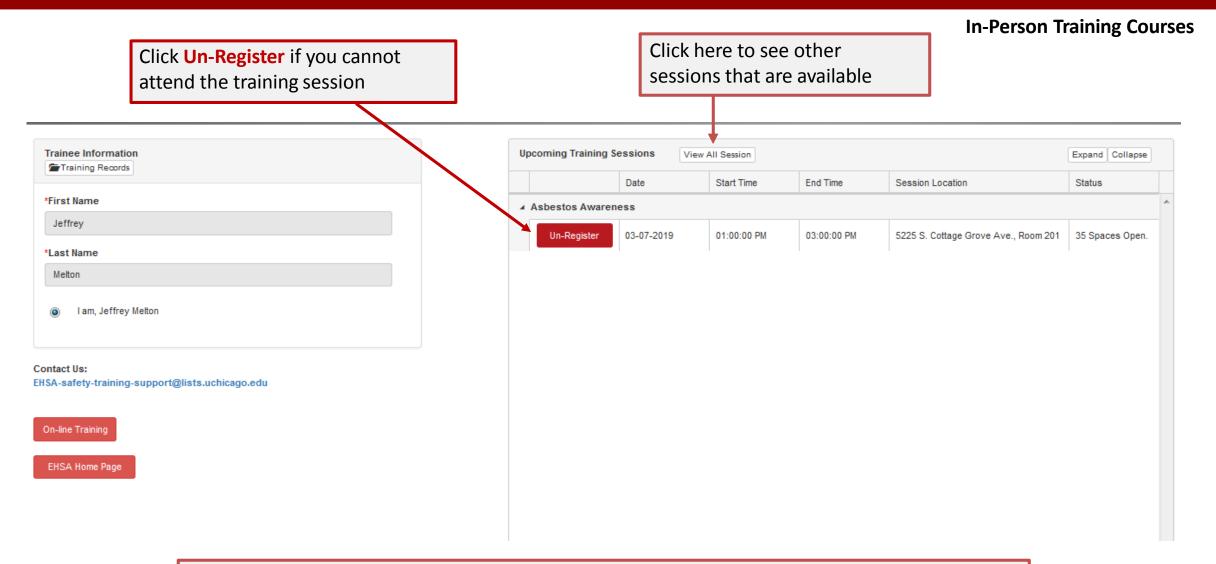
A moveable window will overlay this training registration page.

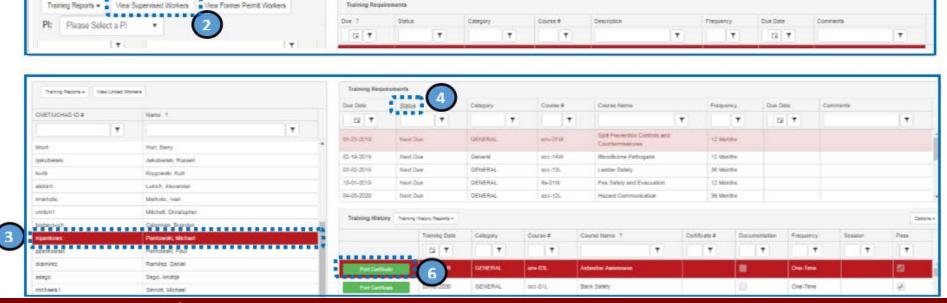


Once you attend the training session, the completion will be recorded within two business days by the safety office which hosted the training

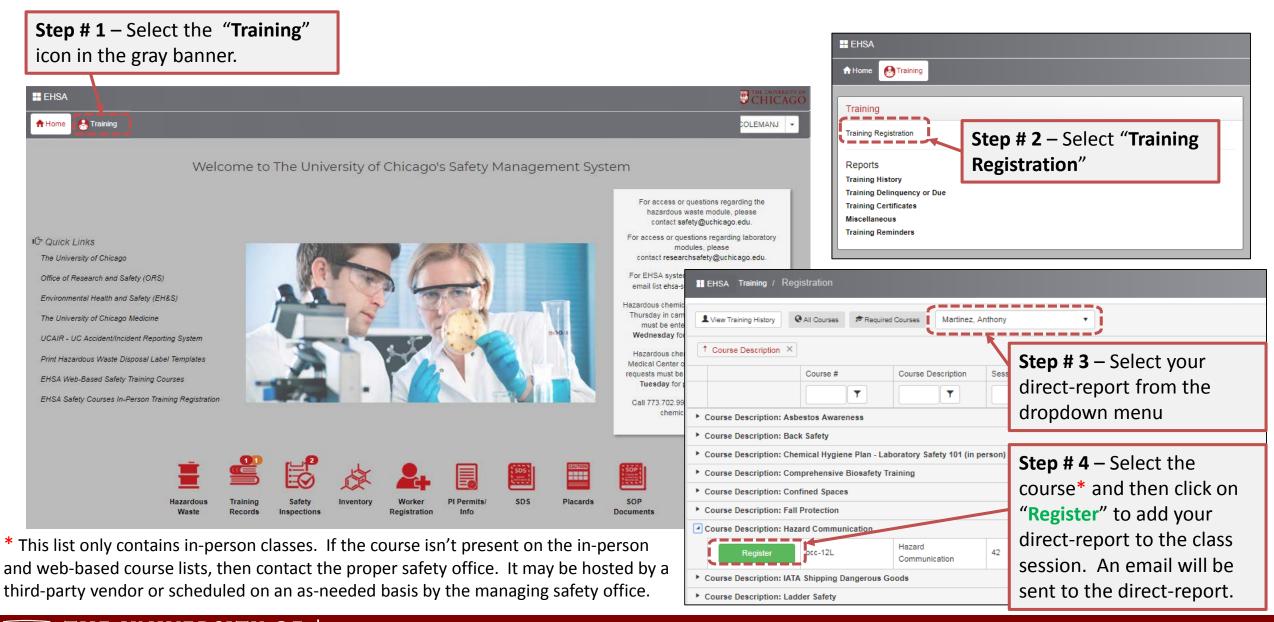
# Supervisors - Accessing Training Records



- 1 Log-in to ehsa.uchicago.edu and click on "Training Records." The table will be empty.
- Click on "View Supervised Workers" to populate table. Please note your training records are also listed. If a direct-report is missing contact EHS (non-lab) or ORS (lab) and we will attach you to the employee.
- 3 Click on an employee to display their training requirements (top table) and training history (bottom table)
- Click on "Status" in the "Training Requirements" table. The overdue courses, which are highlighted in light red, will filter to the top. If you feel the course should not be assigned to the employee contact EHS or ORS. If the course is lab related (Course # pre-fix bio, lab, lsr, rad, shp), then contact the Office of Research Safety (4-2707).
- If you would like to register your direct-reports for lecture courses, use the "Training" link in the gray ribbon across the top of the EHSA Homepage. An email will be sent to the employee when you successfully register them for a course. Your direct-reports can complete webbased classes and register for lecture classes by using the links bordered in yellow.
- 6 Print copies of the training certificate by clicking the green button in the "Training History" table.
