

Labeling—Hazardous Waste Containers

- All waste containers shall be marked with:
 - * The word “**Waste**”;
 - * **Location** where the waste is generated;
 - * The chemical **contents/constituents**; and
 - * **Hazards** associated with the chemical(s).
