## Walk

The Point is on Lake Michigan at about 5500 South. To walk there from the Department, head north on University Avenue. Turn right on 55<sup>th</sup> Street and continue until you hit water. (You will go through a pedestrian tunnel under Lake Shore Drive.)

## **Bus within Hyde Park**

From the Department and many other points in Hyde Park, you can take the 171 bus, which is free with a University ID. It runs infrequently on weekends, so plan ahead with this <u>schedule</u>. Get off the bus at 55<sup>th</sup> and Hyde Park Boulevard (just before the bus turns north), then walk two blocks east.

## **Driving (not recommended)**

The Point is surrounded by residential streets, where parking is hard to find on weekends. Do not park in any of the highrises' lots or at Treasure Island/Walgreens; you will be towed. If you do not see street parking near the Point, your best bet is to park near the Department and take the 171 bus.

## **Bus from elsewhere**

From downtown and points north, take the 6 bus south to 55<sup>th</sup> and Hyde Park Boulevard, then walk two blocks east. The 6 runs every ten to fifteen minutes; a map is available online.
